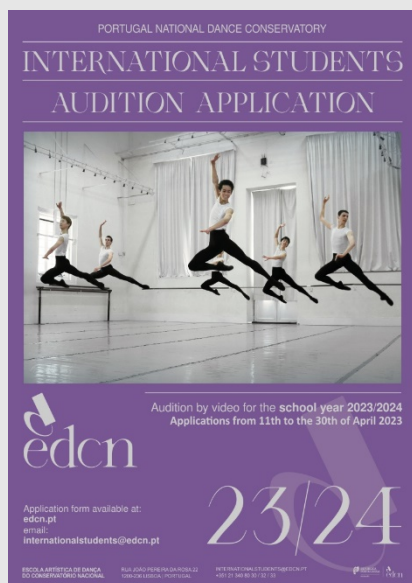


Auditions and Entry Requirements



EUROPEAN AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

GENERAL CONDITIONS

EDCN accepts students for the three last grades of dance training course (6th, 7th and 8th grade) who have completed 18 years of age by the beginning of the school year, and, coming from other countries, wish to attend the disciplines of the Specialized Artistic Area of the Secondary Course for Dancers, as a complement to their training.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- The admission of these students is subject to audition, which may be in person (on the presential auditions dates), or through a Video sent to the School, containing parts of a classical dance class and a contemporary dance class. - This video, similarly to what will happen if the student opts for the face-to-face audition modality, will be viewed by a jury appointed by the Director.

FEES

- Fees for students from European and Portuguese speaking countries – **3,500 euros per annum.**
- Fees for International students – 5,000 euros per annum.
- **Fees should be paid in two installments, with the first installment (50%) due at the time of the enrollment (not refundable), and the second installment (50%) due at the time of the registration.**
- If these payments are not made by the aforementioned deadlines, students will not be able to continue attending classes.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- EDCN offers scholarships at International Dance Competitions as awards to successful competitors wishing to attend the school.
- The school also offers exemption or reduction of annual tuition for students whose parental income is insufficient to cover school fees.
- Parents who wish to apply for exemption or reduction have to provide official documents of income, which are then assessed by the schools' administration. Students will be informed of the final decision within 5 working days by email.

FOLLOW-UP

- These students will be monitored, in terms of their teaching activities, by a Support Office, appointed by the Director, and, subject to availability – reviewed annually – by the School.
- Portuguese Language classes for foreigners can be provided but are however dependent on the availability of teaching staff.
- EDCN accepts no responsibility for authorisation of necessary visas and resident permits for European and International students who wish to attend the school, as well as meals, accommodation and any goods being sent through customs.

VACANCY

- The number of places available for European, Portuguese speaking countries and International students are limited and reviewed annually by the school's direction.
