Auditions and Entry Requirements



EUROPEAN AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

European and International students under the age of 18, independently of their nationality, have to, in compliance with Portuguese legislation, obtain recognition of their equivalencies in general studies from their country of origin.

The school only admits those who complete 16 years old by the beginning of school year.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- The admission of these students is subject to audition, which
 may be in person (on the presential auditions dates), or through
 a Video sent to the School, containing parts of a classical dance
 class and a contemporary dance class. Consult the edcn

- This video, similarly to what will happen if the student opts for the face-to-face audition modality, will be viewed by a jury appointed by the Director.

FEES

 European, Portuguese speaking countries and International students under 18 years of age are exempt from school fees, however the number of places available are limited and are reviewed annually by the school's management.

ATTENDANCE CONDITIONS

- If admitted, it is compulsory for all students to attend and comply with the official full study plan of the EDCN, namely, all subjects included in the General Training and Artistic Training components. Students who wish to opt for distance learning or home schooling from their country of origin should present the necessary documents when registering with EDCN.
- Students under 18 years of age who are admitted to EDCN may only attend if they have acquired a Portuguese residence permit, that can be requested when applying for accommodation, and have appointed a Tutor residing in Portugal.
- EDCN accepts no responsibility for the authorisation of necessary visas and resident permits for European and International students under the age of 18 years who wish to attend the school, as well as meals, accommodation and any goods being sent through customs.
